

Ms. Edwards,

A recall petition against you for the position of Chairman has been delivered, in person, at the Caddo Nation tribal office today, August 21, 2013. Accordingly, it is the duty of the Secretary, with the aid of the Election Board records, to "determine the validity of the names of the signatories to the petition and certify to the Chairperson of the Tribal Council whether or not the petition bears the names of at least fifty (50) of the tribes registered voters" pursuant to the Caddo Nation Recall and Removal Ordinance, 4(e) (4).

Pursuant to the Caddo Nation Constitution and Bylaws, Article X11- Recall, Section 2 (a) "Upon receipt of a valid petition signed by at least fifty (50) of the Tribe's registered voters, it shall be the duty of the Chairman to call and conduct within fifteen (15) days, a special meeting of the membership to consider the recall of a member of the Tribal Council." In accordance with the Caddo Nation Recall and Removal Ordinance 4(a), Section 9, Opening of Meetings: "The Tribal Chairperson shall preside at the recall meeting unless he is subject of such meeting. If the Chairperson cannot preside, the Vice Chairperson shall preside."

PETITION

We, the undersigned registered voters of the Caddo Nation of Oklahoma, are exercising our right to initiate the Recall of a Tribal Council Member in accordance with the Caddo Nation Constitution, Article XII – Recall and Removal, Section 2: Recall (a) “upon receipt of a valid petition signed by at least fifty (50) of the tribe’s registered voters, it shall be the duty of the Chairman to call and conduct within fifteen (15) days, a special meeting of the membership to consider the recall of a member of the Tribal Council.” The undersigned registered voters of the Caddo Nation would like to consider the Recall of Chairperson Brenda Shemayme Edwards for the following violations of the Caddo Nation Constitution and Bylaws:

1. Violation of the Caddo Nation Bylaws, Article I – Oath of Office which reads in part, “I...do hereby...and I will carry out faithfully and impartially the duties of my office to the best of my ability and will promote and protect the interest of the...in the accordance with the tribal constitution and bylaws.”

Brenda Shemayme Edwards has failed to act in the best interest of the Caddo Nation and carry out the duties of her office in an impartial manner, specifically, in regard to the recall/removal of Tribal Council Members.

2. Violation of the Constitution of the Caddo Nation, Article IV, Governing Body, Section 1 - Composition which reads in part, “ The Tribal Council shall consist of four (4) officers elected at large...and at least four (4), but no more than fifteen (15) District Representatives,” and Bylaws, Article II, Meetings, Section 3 - Quorum which reads in part “A majority of the Tribal Council shall constitute a quorum to conduct any business at the monthly Tribal Council meetings.”

Since July 6, 2012, Brenda Shemayme Edwards has failed to convene a legitimate monthly Tribal Council meeting with the required quorum of five (5) Tribal Council members necessary to legally conduct Tribal business.
